About the Michigan IMC

The Michigan Independent Media Center offers citizens the opportunity to both read and report the stories that affect their lives. The web site allows readers to post articles, videos, pictures, and audio online. As the media becomes increasingly consolidated, independent voices are becoming harder to find and the Michigan IMC collects many of these voices. In the future, the Michigan IMC will be producing a news radio show and a newspaper as a way of providing additional access to information.

The Global IMC Network

The Michigan IMC is part of a global network of collectively run media outlets for the creation of radical, accurate, and passionate tellings of the truth. All independent media centers operate under the "open publishing" principle, where everyone can post news. The IMC network emerged after the creation of the Seattle IMC that was setup to cover the protests against the World Trade Organization in November of 1999. In the past six months, the Michigan IMC has covered the Benton Harbor uprising, the battle against the privatization of water in Michigan, protests against Bush and Cheney at recent appearances in Michigan, immigrant rights, the struggle against the USA PATRIOT Act, anti-war activities such as the February 15 anti-war rally in Lansing attended by 3,000 people, and many other events.
