Fellow Employees:

When we announced the launch of our new entrance security system for today, we could not know that the war would begin over night. As these events unfold, it remains critical to be prepared. You will notice increased presence of our police officers as well as sheriffs officers in the complex. It is essential that all employees wear their ID badges to assist this security effort. **All doors on the Plaza Level have been locked down temporarily.** We will re-evaluate this decision periodically.

We expect a variety of anti-war or peace demonstrations around the City. A prayer vigil is planned for Calder Plaza over the noon hour today. Although we do not anticipate any disturbances, we are monitoring events closely.
